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# **Button Battery Injuries**

Children under 2 years old are at the highest risk, especially when ingesting batteries 20mm or larger, leading to severe injuries or fatalities. (The University of Sydney)



## **The Hidden Danger**

Over 70,000 emergency department visits in the U.S. between 2010-2019 were related to battery ingestion or insertion among children under 18. (KevinMD.com)

# **Safety Tips**

• Secure battery compartments on all household devices



- Store spare batteries out of children's reach
- Choose products with child-resistant battery compartments and clear warning labels

#### **Properly Dispose**

Do Not Trash: Never dispose of button batteries in regular trash or recycling bins. Use designated facilities.



### **Emergency Response**

If you suspect a child has ingested a button battery:

Do Not Induce Vomiting

Seek Immediate Medical Attention
